

## 1ST GRADE SUPPLY LIST FOR THE 2010-11 SCHOOL YEAR - MCENDREE

**Please label EVERYTHING with permanent marker.** “Sharpie” markers work on everything.

**Pencils** - #2 Yellow Ticonderoga

**Erasers** - 4 pink pearl or similar kind. NO ART GUM, please, as they break much too easily.

**Pocket Folders** - four, one for each quarter.

**Crayons** - Crayola 24 pack only.

**Watercolors** - Prang 8 (recycle kindergarten Prang paints, if possible).

**Glue** - White school glue. Don't get “no run” glue because it is hard to squeeze out. NO GLUE STICKS! Prefer Elmer's glue - not Rose Art school glue.

**Scissors** - Prefer pointed Fiskars brand.

**Art Supply Box** - Necessary to keep supplies organized (plastic cigar box size only).

**Art Shirt** - makes a neater kid to send home after art class. This could be a parent's old T-shirt.

**Coloring Book** - Two coloring books or fun pads to keep in desk to be used when student must stay in from recess due to colds, etc. Student keeps one in desk, and teacher keeps extra book until January.

**Old Washcloth** - to erase student chalkboard.

**Ziploc Bags** - Girls bring quart size; boys bring gallon size.

**Kleenex** - 2 boxes.

**Paper towels** - 2 pack.

**Canister of Pre-sweetened Kool Aid** - Boys bring.

**Wipes** - Girls bring.

**Backpack** - **Clear** backpacks are recommended for safety reasons. It is easier for important work pages and information letters to get home if your child has something in which to carry them. Please **do not** bring backpacks with **wheels** because these are too large to fit into the lockers.

Please do **NOT** bring pencil sharpeners, markers, or colored pencils.

**THIRD GRADE SUPPLY LIST**

Classroom supplies are a very important part of your child's school year. These supplies are used daily. It is very important that your child has the needed tools to do his/her job during the school year. While the local merchants sell fancy, cool, and often expensive tools, your child requires only the basic tools. What we teachers are trying to say is save the cool supplies for home, and send the basics to school. The following is what your child will need as a third grader at McEndree School.

- **\*Pencils** - #2 wood (no mechanical/refillable)
- **Erasers** - pencil top or Pink Pearl
- **\*Paper** - wide-ruled, spiral or loose-leaf notebook
- **Folders** - 3B and 3C-4 plain colored pocket folders; none for 3A

Small, snap-close **art box** that will hold the following:

- **24 or fewer crayons**
  - **12 or fewer colored pencils**
  - **\*White school glue** - Elmer's (do not buy the No Run)
  - **Scissors** - Fiskars are preferred
- NO ink pens or markers in 3C**

Your child may also need watercolor paints. Save money, and use last year's paints.

The following items are needed for the classroom:

- **\*Facial tissues** - 2 boxes of Kleenex or Puffs
- **Paper towels** - 3 rolls
- **Plastic Zip-loc bags** -
  - Last names A-O - sandwich or snack size bags
  - Last names P-Z - gallon or quart size bags
- **Clorox wipes**

All students need a **book bag**. The clear book bags are nice because it is easy for the teacher to see if the students have what they need. **Please do not send bags with wheels because they do not fit into the lockers.** We also ask that the children do not bring large binders, large art boxes, or Trapper Keepers.

Please label your child's supplies with permanent marker.

**\*These classroom supplies often get lost, traded, broken, and emptied so please send replacements during the year.**

**SECOND GRADE SUPPLY LIST**

Classroom supplies are a very important part of your child's school year. These supplies are used daily. It is very important that your child has the needed tools to do his/her job during the school year. The following is what your child will need as a second grader at McEndree School.

- **Pencils** - 1 dozen #2 wood (several, already sharpened)
- **Covered pencil sharpener** (Cost is under \$1.)
- **Erasers** - 2 Pink Pearl
- **Folders** - 6 pocket folders
- **Art Box** - small
- **24 or fewer crayons**
- **Markers**
- **12 or fewer colored pencils**
- **White school glue** - 3 small bottles Elmer's (Do not buy the no-run.)
- **Scissors** - Fiskars are preferred
- **Watercolor paints** - Prang are best. May use last year's paints.
- **Facial tissues** - 2 boxes
- **Paper towels**
- **Plastic bags**
  - Sandwich bags - last name beginning with A-M
  - Gallon bags - last name beginning with N-Z
- **Notebooks** - 2 spirals, 70 sheets - 1 subject - wide ruled
- **Clorox Wipes** - girls bring
- **1 Canister pre-sweetened Kool Aid** - boys bring

All students need a **book bag**. Please do not send bags with wheels because they do not fit into the lockers. We also ask that the children do not bring large binders or large art boxes.

## **4TH GRADE SUPPLY LIST FOR THE 2009/2010 SCHOOL YEAR - XENIA**

Classroom supplies are a very important part of your child's school year. These supplies are used daily. It is very important that your child has the needed tools to do his/her job during the school year. While the local merchants sell fancy, cool, and often expensive tools, your child requires only the basic supplies. Please save the "cool" supplies for home, and send the basics to school. The following is what your child will need as a fourth grader at Xenia School:

- **Pencils** - 1 pkg. of disposable mechanical pencils. Please **do not** send mechanical pencils that require refills.
- **Red Pens** - 2
- **Expo Dry Erase Markers** (Black or blue would be best.)
- **Highlighter Pen**
- **1 Sharpie Marker**
- **12 or fewer Colored Pencils**
- **24 or fewer Crayons**
- **Erasers** - 2 **pink pearl** (The pencil erasers do not do the job.)
- **Ruler**
- **White School Glue** - Elmer's (do not buy "No Run")
- **Scissors** - Fiskar's are preferred
- **Paper** - wide-ruled, loose-leaf notebook (NO spiral notebooks)
- **Folders** - 4 pocket folders
- **No Huge Binders**
- **Art Box** - small, snap-close (space saver) box to hold crayons, colored pencils, glue, & scissors
- **Facial Tissues** - 2 boxes of Kleenex or Puffs
- **Paper Towels** - 1 roll
- **Ziploc Bags** - Students A-L - gallon size  
M-Z - quart size
- Your child may also need **Watercolor Paints**. Save money and use last year's.

All students need a **Book Bag**. **Please do not send large backpacks because space is limited in our room. NO book bags with wheels.** Please label your child's supplies with a permanent marker. An optional pair of **Tennis Shoes** may be kept at school because it is hard to play P.E. and recess wearing sandals, clogs, boots, or shoes with hard soles on the gym floor. Please replenish supplies every quarter.

## **SC1 SUPPLY LIST FOR 2010-2011 FOR MCENDREE SCHOOL**

Please label everything with permanent marker. “Sharpie” markers work on everything.

Pencils - #2 lead with eraser. Please start the year with six pencils.

Paper - 2 manuscript writing tablets

Crayons - 16 or 24 - size

Watercolors - Prang 8 or Crayola 8

Glue - White school glue and 2 glue sticks

Scissors - Pointed or blunt; they do make left-handed scissors for the left-handed child

Erasers - Pink pearl or similar kind

Ruler - Older students only: inches and centimeters on it

Kleenex - 2 boxes

Paper towels - 1 roll

Art supply box - plastic cigar box size

Backpack - **Very important!!!!** Clear backpacks are recommended. Please do not send book bags on wheels because they do not fit into the lockers.

Coloring book - 1 coloring book or fun pad

Tennis shoes - optional for P. E. and recess

Pocket folders - 1

Change of clothes - if you feel it is necessary
