1ST GRADE SUPPLY LIST

Dear Parent: This list may help you with your child's school supplies for the coming year. Please label everything with permanent marker. "Sharpie" markers work the best.

Pencils: No. 2 lead with eraser. Regular size is fine. First graders are pretty rough on pencils. It is usually nice to begin the year with about 12 pencils, and then send a few new ones every few weeks.

(2) red lead pencils.

Crayons: I would prefer 24 size rather than large boxes. The 24 size fits nicely in the supply box. Also, rather than spend money on a large box, that same amount can replace the 24 size several times during the year.

Watercolors: Prang 8 and Crayola 8 are the best. We know others are less expensive, but their colors do not tint the page and the brushes are too small.

Markers: Washable. Crayola Classic Colors are best.
(1) Black Sharpie Marker (Fine Point)
Expo Dry Erase Marker - Black or blue would be best.

Glue: (2) Bottles of white school glue
(2) Glue Sticks

- Scissors:** Pointed or blunt. Left-handed scissors are available.
- Eraser:** (2) Pink pearl or similar kind. **NO ART GUM PLEASE**, as they break much too easily.
- Notebook:** (1) Spiral-ring Notebook
- Kleenex:** (2) Boxes
- Paper Towels:** (1) Roll
- Ziploc Baggies:** (1) Gallon size box (A-M)
(1) Quart size box (N-Z)
- Art Supply Box:** This is necessary to keep supplies organized. A large 11 x 7 plastic box is preferred.
- Book Bag:** Please get your child a book bag of some type. **NO** book bags with wheels. It is easier for important work pages and informational letters to get home if your child has something in which to carry them.

ONE coloring book or fun pad to keep in the desk to be used when student has free time (replace book as needed).

An optional pair of tennis shoes may be kept at school by the Xenia students because they will not be permitted to wear sandals, clogs, boots or shoes with hard soles on the gym floor.
